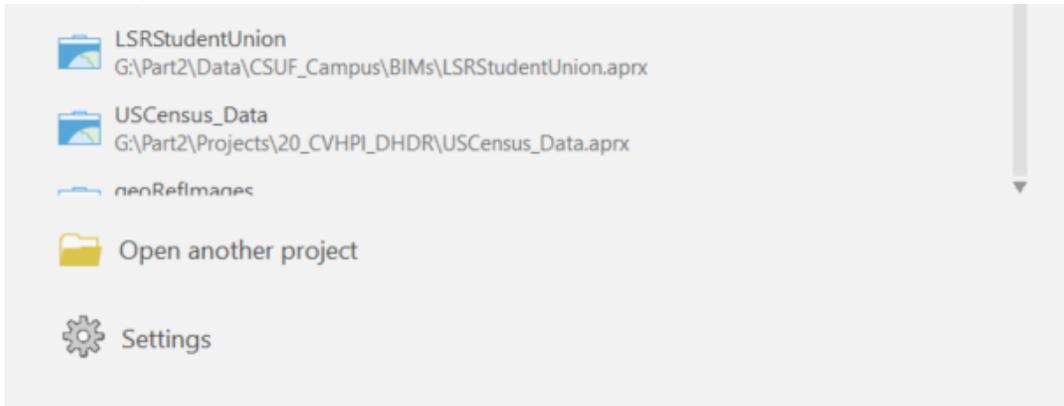
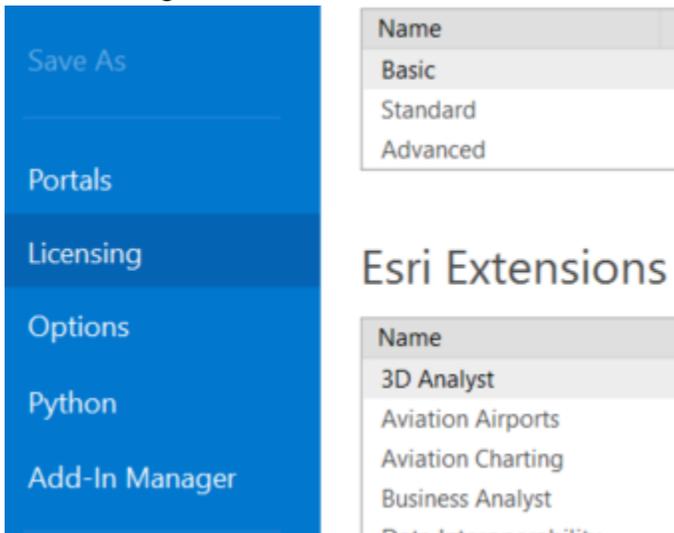


## How to License ArcGIS Pro Installed on Your Personal Computer

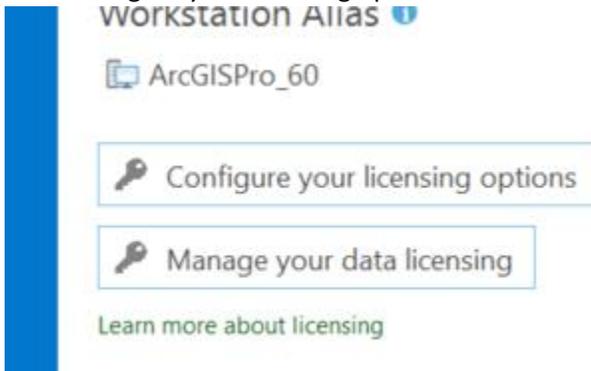
1. Start ArcGIS Pro
2. Click Settings at the bottom left of the window



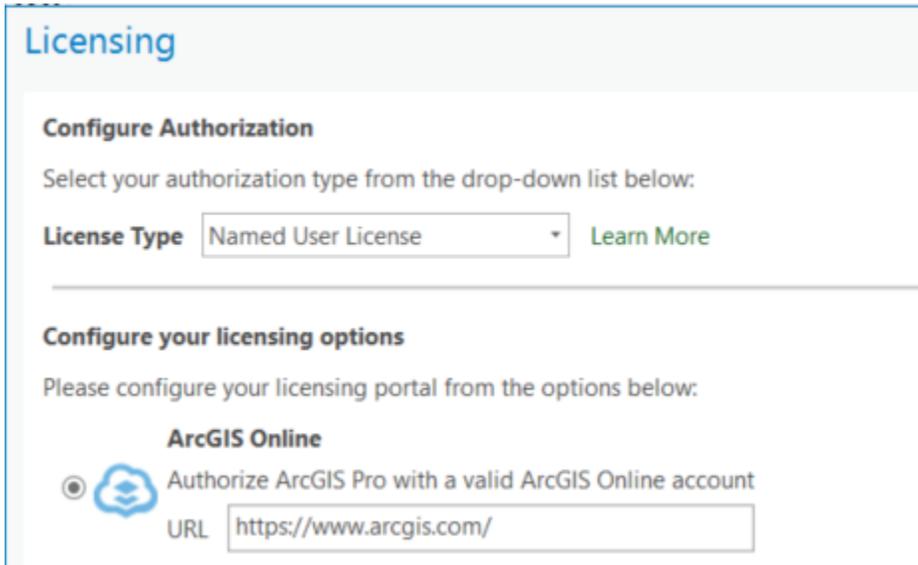
3. Click Licensing on the left



4. Click Configure your licensing options

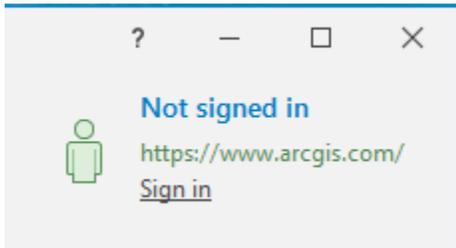


5. Set License Type to Named User License and click ArcGIS Online Authorize ArcGIS Pro with a valid ArcGIS Online account

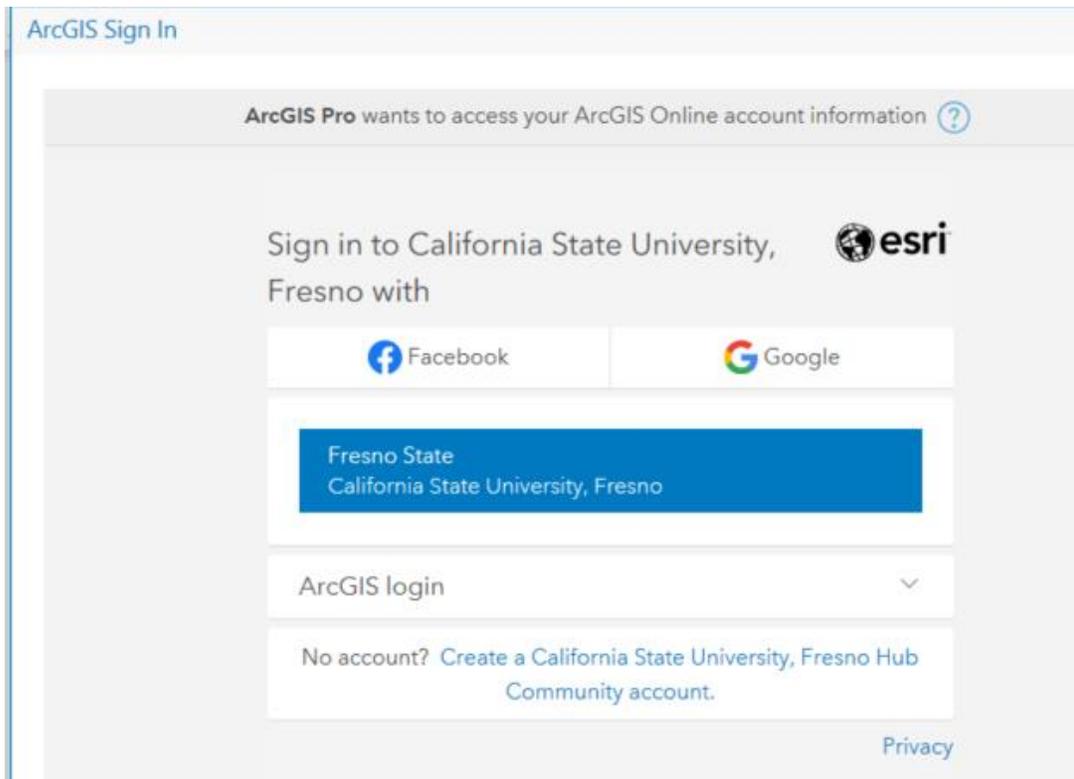

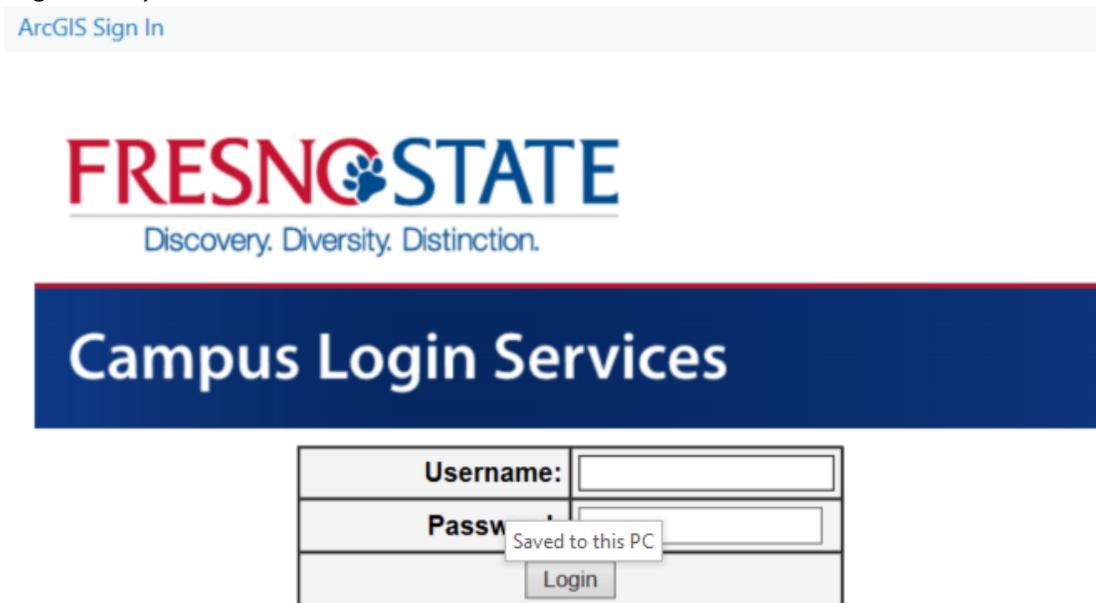
